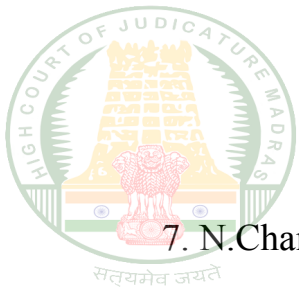

PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 to 6 to take necessary action against respondents 7 to 14 based upon the complaint made by the petitioner dated 26.03.2025 by considering the petitioner's representation dated 08.04.2026.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the respondents 1 to 6 to take necessary action against respondents 7 to 14 based upon the complaint made by the petitioner dated 26.03.2025 by considering the petitioner's representation dated 08.04.2026.



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2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that respondents 7 to 14 had allegedly swindled a sum of nearly Rs.1.5 crores from the petitioner, who is carrying on business under the name and style of 'Trichy Pasumai Groundnut Producer Company Ltd.,' at Pannapatti East, Manaparai Taluk, Tiruchirappalli District. It is submitted that, in this regard, the petitioner had lodged a complaint before the respondent police seeking appropriate action. Since no action was taken on the said complaint, the present writ petition came to be filed.

3. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent police submitted that, pursuant to the petitioner's complaint, both the petitioner and the private respondents were summoned, and a discreet enquiry was conducted. During the enquiry, it was revealed that respondents 7 and 8 are the Directors of the aforesaid company and that the dispute essentially pertains to the company's financial transactions and the discrepancies arising out of its business affairs. It was further submitted that the respondent police are unable to proceed further with the enquiry in the absence of the necessary documents and transaction records from the petitioner substantiating his claim. The learned Government Advocate further submitted that the petitioner has an



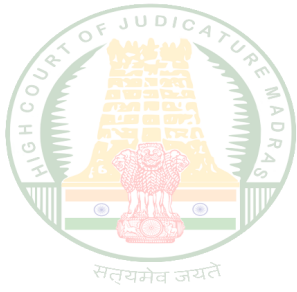
efficacious statutory remedy under Section 242(1)(a) of the Companies Act, 2013, before the competent forum.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either sides and carefully perused the materials available on record. Since no adverse order is proposed to be passed against the fourth respondent, notice to him is dispensed with.

5. Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent police, this writ petition stands disposed of, granting liberty to the petitioner to work out his remedy before the competent forum, if so advised.
