**O R D E R**  
**(Hybrid Mode)**

**05.05.2026:** This appeal is against an impugned order dated 17.04.2026 passed by the Ld. National Company Law Tribunal, New Delhi Bench-II in *CP. No. 137 of 2023*. The order is as follows:

*“ORDER*

*CA-65/ND/2026, IA-122/ND/2026: List the applications for hearing on 21.04.2026 at 11:00 am.*

*Ms. Veena Gupta need not to remain present physically on the next date of hearing.”*

2. We have heard learned Counsels appearing for both the sides. The controversy that appears to us is the execution of a letter dated 16.08.2025, purportedly signed by the respondent, wherein she has stated she intends to withdraw C.P. No. 137/2023/241-242 pending before the Ld. NCLT, New Delhi Bench.

3. It is argued later the respondent alleged the letter dated 16.08.2025 is a forged one. It led to the filing of applications *viz.* CA-301/ND/2025 by the respondent and CA-302/ND/2025, CA-122/ND/2026 and CA-257/ND/2025 by the appellant. We have noted the prayer made in CA-122/ND/2026 to the effect the respondent may be directed to appear and certain clarifications be sought with regard to the fraudulent filing; in circumstances surrounding the letter dated 16.08.2025.

4. On hearing we find the applications are all listed on 09.06.2026 along with CP. No. 137 of 2023 and we dispose of this appeal by requesting the Ld. NCLT to hear these applications, and if the court is of the opinion the presence of respondent is essential, it may give directions accordingly.

5. In view of the above, the appeal is disposed of. Pending I.A.s, if any, are also disposed of.
