4. The present Civil Appeal arises out of the judgment and order dated 27th February, 2026, passed by the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, in Company Appeal (AT)(Insolvency) No.357 of 2026.
5. By the impugned judgment and order, the Appellate Tribunal dismissed the appeal preferred by the appellant, observing as under:

“Appellant is an operational creditor and under the scheme of the IBC and the CIRP Regulation, he is not entitled for the copy of the Resolution Plan. When the court has granted liberty to the Appellant to challenge the plan, it is always open for the Appellant to file appropriate Application objecting to the new Resolution Plan raising all permissible pleas in accordance with law.”

6. Having considered the matter in its entirety and perusing the material available on record, we do not find

any good ground to interfere with the impugned judgment and order.

7. Accordingly, the Civil Appeal stands dismissed.
